AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1944.

B E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Scat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Super-* Short title annuation Ordinance 1945.*

- (2.) The *Police Superannuation Ordinance* 1928-1944, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance* 1928-1945.
- **2.** Section three c of the *Police Superannuation Ordinance* Former 1928-1944 is amended—

 Police Former Police F
 - (a) by inserting in sub-section (1.), after the word "Force" (second occurring), the words "or of the Prisons Branch of the Public Service of the Branch of the Public Service "; and
 - (b) by inserting in that sub-section, after the word "Force" (fourth occurring), the words "or Prisons Branch of the Public Service".
