AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1944.

B E it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Industrial Board* short title. Ordinance 1945.*
- (2.) The *Industrial Board Ordinance* 1936-1944, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Industrial Board Ordinance* 1936-1945.
- 2. Section seven A of the Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1944 Continuance in office of elected members of
 - (a) by omitting the word "forty-four" and inserting in its the Board. stead the word "forty-five"; and
 - (b) by omitting the word "forty-five" and inserting in its stead the word "forty-six".
