AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1944.

BE it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1945*.^{*} Short title.

(2.) The *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1944*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1945*.

2. Section seven A of the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1944* is amended— Continuance in office of elected members of the Board.

- (a) by omitting the word “forty-four” and inserting in its stead the word “forty-five”; and
- (b) by omitting the word “forty-five” and inserting in its stead the word “forty-six”.
