## AN ORDINANCE

### To amend the Companies Ordinance 1931-1938.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909-1938 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1947, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Companies Ordinance* 1949. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Companies Ordinance* 1931-1938, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Companies Ordinance* 1931-1949.

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and forty-eight. Commencement.

3. After section twelve of the *Companies Ordinance* 1931-1938 the following section is inserted:—

“12A. Section three of the Companies (Amendment) Act, 1906 of the State of New South Wales in its application to the Territory is amended by inserting after paragraph (e) the following word and paragraph:—

‘; or (f) to sell or dispose of the whole or any part of the undertaking of the company’.” Power for company to alter objects subject to confirmation by Court.
