AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1947.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1950*.^{* Short title and citation.}

(2.) The *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1947* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1950*.

2. Section twenty-one of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (4.) the words "but so that an interval greater than one month shall not occur between any two consecutive meetings" and inserting in their stead the words "but so that a meeting shall be held in each of the twelve calendar months".^{Meetings of the Board.}

3.—(1.) Section twenty-five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-sections (2.) and (3.) and inserting in their stead the following sub-section:—^{Power of Board to appoint staff.}

"(2.) Subject to any Act, providing for the determination of terms and conditions of employment, which is applicable, a person appointed under this section shall be engaged for such period as the Board, subject to the directions of the Minister and with his concurrence, determines, and his employment shall be at such salary, wages or rate of pay, and upon such terms and conditions, as the Board, subject to the directions of the Minister and with his concurrence, determines."

(2.) The amendment made by this section shall not affect the operation of section four of the *Industrial Board Ordinance* 1949.
