AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1947.

The it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Canberra Com-short title and citation, munity Hospital Ordinance 1950.*

- (2.) The Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1947 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1950.
- 2. Section twenty-one of the Principal Ordinance is amended Meetings of the Board. by omitting from sub-section (4.) the words "but so that an interval greater than one month shall not occur between any two consecutive meetings" and inserting in their stead the words "but so that a meeting shall be held in each of the twelve calendar months".

3.—(1.) Section twenty-five of the Principal Ordinance is Power of Board amended by omitting sub-sections (2.) and (3.) and inserting in their stead the following sub-section:-

"(2.) Subject to any Act, providing for the determination of terms and conditions of employment, which is applicable, a person appointed under this section shall be engaged for such period as the Board, subject to the directions of the Minister and with his concurrence, determines, and his employment shall be at such salary, wages or rate of pay, and upon such terms and conditions, as the Board, subject to the directions of the Minister and with his concurrence, determines.".
