An Ordinance to amend the *Alsatian Dogs Ordinance* 1936.

Short title

Keeping an unsterilized

Alsatian dog as companion

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Alsatian Dogs Ordinance 1961.*
- (2.) The Alsatian Dogs Ordinance 1936,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Alsatian Dogs Ordinance 1936-1961.
- 2. After section seven of the Alsatian Dogs Ordinance 1936 the following section is added:—
- "8. Nothing in this Ordinance applies to a person who keeps an Alsatian dog, or to such a dog, if—
 - (a) the dog is a pure-bred German shepherd dog;
 - (b) the dog is registered as a pure-bred German shepherd dog with the association known as the Canberra Kennel Association or another association that is for the time being approved by the Registrar;
 - (c) the keeper of the dog is a member of the club known as the A.C.T. Companion Dog Club Incorporated or another club that is for the time being approved by the Registrar; and
 - (d) the Registrar certifies that he is satisfied that the dog—
 - (i) has satisfied the requirements of the rules of the Canberra Kennel Association or other approved association as the requirements to be satisfied before a pure-bred German shepherd dog is regarded as a companion dog; or
 - (ii) is being trained for the purpose of satisfying those requirements.".
