AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1939.*

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1939*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1940*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1939* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1940*.

2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from the definition of "City Area" the figures "1924-1929" and inserting in their stead the figures "1936-1938". Definition of "City Area".

3. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-section (2.) the words "or plantation in the City Area" and inserting in their stead the words "plantation or afforestation area". Trespass on Commonwealth lands.

4. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the following words:— Damaging trees, &c.

"or plantation which—

(a) is in the City Area; and

(b) belongs to, or is",

and inserting in their stead the words "plantation or afforestation area belonging to,".

5. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "or plantation" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "plantation or afforestation area". Persons authorized to prevent trespassing, &c.
