AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1939.*

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1939, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Trespass on short title commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1940.
- (2.) The Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1939 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance* 1932-1940.
- 2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Definition of omitting from the definition of "City Area" the figures "1924-"City Area". 1929" and inserting in their stead the figures "1936-1938".
- 3. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Trespass on omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-section (2.) the words "or Commonwealth plantation in the City Area" and inserting in their stead the words ", plantation or afforestation area".
- 4. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Damaging omitting the following words:—

"or plantation which-

(a) is in the City Area; and

(b) belongs to, or is",

and inserting in their stead the words ", plantation or afforestation area belonging to,".

5. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Persons omitting the words "or plantation" (wherever occurring) and prevent inserting in their stead the words ", plantation or afforestation trespassing, &c. area".
