AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1943*, as amended by the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1944*.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance (No. 2) 1944*.^{* Short title and citation.}

(2.) Section one of the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1944* is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).

(3.) The *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1943*, as amended by the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1944*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1944*.

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date of the commencement of the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1944*.^{Commencement.}

3. Section three B of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the words "Penalty: Ten pounds".^{Trespassing on lawns and grassed areas.}
