ADMINISTRATION AND PROBATE ORDINANCE 1974

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Administration and Short title Probate Ordinance 1974.*

(2) The Administration and Probate Ordinance 1929-1970,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Administration and Probate Ordinance 1929-1974.

2. Section 76 of the Administration and Probate Ordinance 1929-Duties of Registrar. 1970 is amended by omitting sub-section (3).
