BUILDING (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1976

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Building (Amendment) Short title. Ordinance 1976.*
- 2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Building Principal Ordinance. Ordinance 1972.†
 - 3. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

- 4. After section 13 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted in Division 2 of Part II:-
- "13A. The Review Committee shall, as soon as practicable after Annual the end of each financial year, prepare and furnish to the Minister a report of Review report of the operations of the Review Committee during that year.".

- 5. After section 26 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—
- "26A. The Standards Committee shall, as soon as practicable after Annual the end of each financial year, prepare and furnish to the Minister a report of the operations of the Standards Committee during that year.". Committee.
