REGISTRATION OF DEEDS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1977

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Deeds Short title (Amendment) Ordinance 1977.*

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Registration Principal Ordinance of Deeds Ordinance 1957.⁺

3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 3 October 1977. Commence-

4. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting Registration from sub-section (1) "Two dollars" and substituting "\$10". of deeds

5. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting Searches ", upon payment of a fee of Fifty cents,".

6. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1) " the prescribed fee " and substituting "a fee of \$1 for every page included in the certified copy "; and
- (b) by omitting sub-section (2).
