#### WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1978

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation Short title (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1978.\*
- 2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Work-Principal men's Compensation Ordinance 1951.†
- 3. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting Interpretfrom sub-section (9) "1 January 1979" and substituting "1 July 1979".
- 4. Section 4 of the Workmen's Compensation (Amendment) Repeal Ordinance 1978 is repealed.
- 5. On and after 1 July 1979, the Interpretation Ordinance 1967 Certain has effect in relation to sub-sections 6 (4A), (4B), (4C), (4D), (4E) and (10) of the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance deemed to as if those sub-sections had been repealed on that day by an Ordinance.
