An Ordinance to amend the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977*

**Short title**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1981*.<sup>1</sup>

**Interpretation**

2. Section 4 of the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977*<sup>2</sup> is amended by omitting "intoxicating liquor" (wherever occurring) from the definition of "offence involving alcohol or drugs" in sub-section (1) and substituting "alcohol".
