An Ordinance to amend the *Court of Petty Sessions Ordinance 1930*

### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Court of Petty Sessions (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 3) 1984*.<sup>1</sup>

### Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Court of Petty Sessions Ordinance 1930*.<sup>2</sup>

### Appeals to which this Division applies

3. Section 208 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by inserting in paragraph (1) (a) "or Part VIIA" after "Part VII"; and
- (b) by inserting in paragraph (1) (c) "or Part VIIA" after "Part VII".

**Appeals by way or orders to review**

4. Section 219B of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by inserting in paragraph (a) “or Part VIIA” after “Part VII”; and
  - (b) by inserting in paragraph (b) “or Part VIIA” after “Part VII”.
