## Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) (Amendment) Ordinance 1984

An Ordinance to amend the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977*

### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) (Amendment) Ordinance 1984*.<sup>1</sup>

### Conditional release of offenders after conviction

2. Section 29 of the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977*<sup>2</sup> is amended by omitting all the words from and including “the Court” (first occurring) to and including “may,” and substituting “the Court, on an application by the convicted person, may,”.
