## Standard Time and Summer Time (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1986

An Ordinance to amend the *Standard Time and Summer Time Ordinance 1972*

### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Standard Time and Summer Time (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1986*.<sup>1</sup>

### Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Standard Time and Summer Time Ordinance 1972*.<sup>2</sup>

### Interpretation

3. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the definition of "daylight saving period" and substituting the following definition:

“ ‘daylight saving period’ means a period in respect of which a declaration of the Minister under section 5A is in force;”.

4. After section 5 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:

**Declaration of daylight saving period**

“5A. The Minister may, by notice published in the *Gazette*, declare a period to be a daylight saving period for the purposes of this Ordinance.”.

**Repeal of section 7**

5. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.
