An Ordinance to amend the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977*

### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) (Amendment) Ordinance 1987*.<sup>1</sup>

### Right of arrested person to medical examination

2. Section 47 of the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977*<sup>2</sup> is amended by omitting from sub-section (1) "section 34, Part V or VI" and substituting "section 34, section 46, Part V or Part VI".
