Interim Planning (Amendment) Act 1991

No. 29 of 1991

An Act to amend the *Interim Planning Act 1990*

[Notified in ACT Gazette S79: 7 August 1991]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Interim Planning (Amendment) Act 1991*.

Principal Act

2. In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *Interim Planning Act 1990*.¹

Interim effect of draft Plan variations

3. Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from the end of paragraph (b) of the definition of “defined period” in subsection (2) “or”; and

- (b) by inserting after paragraph (b) of that definition the following paragraph:

“(ba) the date the Executive revokes its approval of the variation; or”.

Executive powers

4. Section 19 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsections:

“(3) The Executive may revoke its approval of a Plan at any time before the Plan is laid before the Legislative Assembly.

“(4) Where the Executive revokes its approval of a Plan it shall cause to be published in the *Gazette* a notice stating—

- (a) that the approval of the Plan has been revoked; and
- (b) in the case of a Plan variation—the effect of section 9 in relation to the revocation of the approval.”.
