## **Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) (Amendment) Act 1996**

### **An Act to amend the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977***

*[Notified in ACT Gazette S234: 19 September 1996]*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

#### **Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) (Amendment) Act 1996*.

#### **Commencement**

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

#### **Principal Act**

3. In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977*.<sup>1</sup>

### **Interpretation**

4. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the definition of “Commonwealth vehicle” and substituting the following definition:

“ ‘Commonwealth vehicle’ means a motor vehicle that is owned by the Commonwealth and—

- (a) bears a label attached to the windscreen that displays the letter ‘C’ followed by a 7-pointed star, both in white against a blue background, and the word ‘COMCAR’ in blue against a white background; or
- (b) is, or is within a class of motor vehicles that is, declared by the Minister, by instrument published in the *Gazette*, to be a Commonwealth vehicle for the purposes of this Act;”.
