Health Professions Boards (Procedures) (Amendment) Act (No. 2) 1997

No. 110 of 1997

An Act to amend the *Health Professions Boards (Procedures) Act 1981*

[Notified in ACT Gazette S420: 24 December 1997]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Health Professions Boards (Procedures) (Amendment) Act (No. 2) 1997*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *Health Professions Boards (Procedures) Act 1981*.¹

Remuneration

4. Section 13 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsection:

“(3) A member is entitled to remuneration for time spent sitting on the Board for the hearing of a proceeding.”.

Conduct of proceedings

5. Section 23 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (1) “or any member who is a legal practitioner” after “Board” (second occurring).
