Territory Owned Corporations (Amendment) Act (No. 4) 1997

No. 118 of 1997

An Act to amend the *Territory Owned Corporations Act 1990*

[Notified in ACT Gazette S420: 24 December 1997]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Territory Owned Corporations (Amendment) Act (No. 4) 1997*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *Territory Owned Corporations Act 1990*.¹

Annual report

4. Section 22 of the Principal Act is amended by—
- (a) omitting from subsection (1) “4 months” and substituting “the prescribed time”;

- (b) omitting from subsection (4) “15” and substituting “6”; and
- (c) inserting in subsection (5) the following definition:

“ ‘prescribed time’ means the time fixed under section 11 of the *Annual Reports (Government Agencies) Act 1995* or, if that time has been extended in accordance with that Act, that time as extended;”.
