

# Remuneration Tribunal (Consequential Amendments) Act 1997

No. 41 of 1997

## An Act to amend certain laws consequent on the enactment of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995*

[Notified in ACT Gazette S264: 19 September 1997]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

## **Short title**

**1.** This Act may be cited as the *Remuneration Tribunal (Consequential Amendments) Act 1997.* 

## Commencement

- **2.** (1) Section 1 and this section commence on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*.
- (2) The remaining provisions commence on a day, or respective days, fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

(3) If the remaining sections have not commenced before the end of the period of 6 months commencing on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*, those provisions, by force of this subsection, commence on the first day after the end of that period.

## **Amendments and repeal**

- **3.** (1) The Acts specified in Schedule 1 are amended as set out in Schedule 1.
- (2) The Regulations specified in Schedule 2 are amended or repealed as set out in Schedule 2.
