An Act to amend the Duties Act 1999

Notified under the Legislation Act 2001 on 17 April 2002 (see www.legislation.act.gov.au)

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Duties Amendment Act 2002*.

### 2 Commencement

(1) Section 4 commences on the day this Act is notified.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 75).

(2) The remaining provisions are taken to have commenced on 1 March 1999.

### 3 Act amended

This Act amends the Duties Act 1999.

(3) For this section:

**reinsurance** means a contract or contracts between 2 parties by which one party indemnifies the other against liability or payment under a contract or contracts of insurance or reinsurance.
