Part 1 Preliminary

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Dangerous Substances (Asbestos) Amendment Act 2005 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

- (1) This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

- (2) To remove any doubt, the Legislation Act, section 79A (Commencement of amendment of uncommenced law) does not apply to the amendments made by this Act.
