

# Holidays (Family and Community Day) Amendment Act 2009

A2009-46

An Act to amend the Holidays Act 1958

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Holidays (Family and Community Day) Amendment Act* 2009.

#### 2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

### 3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the Holidays Act 1958.

*substituted public holiday* means a day that is a public holiday because another day mentioned in subsection (1) (a) is a Saturday or Sunday.
