Holidays (Family and Community Day) Amendment Act 2009

An Act to amend the *Holidays Act 1958*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Holidays (Family and Community Day) Amendment Act 2009*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the *Holidays Act 1958*.

Family and Community Day means—

substituted public holiday means a day that is a public holiday because another day mentioned in subsection (1) (a) is a Saturday or Sunday.
