An Act to provide for the number of members of the Legislative Assembly

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Australian Capital Territory (Legislative Assembly) Act 2014*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

**3 Number of Legislative Assembly members—
Self-Government Act, s 8 (2)**

- (1) This Act is made for the purposes of the *Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Act 1988* (Cwlth), section 8 (2).
- (2) The Legislative Assembly is to consist of 25 members.
- (3) Subsection (2) applies to the Legislative Assembly constituted by members elected at a general election after the commencement of this Act.
