# Remuneration Tribunal Amendment Act 2021

An Act to amend the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995*

---

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

**1 Name of Act**

This Act is the *Remuneration Tribunal Amendment Act 2021*.

**2 Commencement**

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

**3 Legislation amended**

This Act amends the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995*.

**4 Inquiries about members of Legislative Assembly  
New section 9 (3) (da)**

(da) the Whip in the Legislative Assembly of a registered party (other than the party to which the Chief Minister or Leader of the Opposition belongs) if at least 4 members of the Legislative Assembly are members of the party;

**5 New section 9 (4)**

(4) In this section:

*registered party*—see the *Electoral Act 1992*, dictionary.
