An Act to amend the Senior Practitioner Act 2018

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Senior Practitioner Amendment Act 2022.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on a day fixed by the Minister by written notice.

- *Note 1* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
- *Note* 2 A single day or time may be fixed, or different days or times may be fixed, for the commencement of different provisions (see Legislation Act, s 77 (1)).
- *Note 3* If a provision has not commenced within 6 months beginning on the notification day, it automatically commences on the first day after that period (see Legislation Act, s 79).

3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the Senior Practitioner Act 2018.
