An Act to appropriate additional money for the purposes of the Territory for the financial year that began on 1 July 2024

---

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

**1 Name of Act**

This Act is the *Appropriation Act 2024-2025 (No 2)*.

**2 Commencement**

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

**3 Purposes of Act**

This Act is made for the purposes of—

- (a) the [Self-Government Act](#), section 57 and section 58; and
- (b) the [Financial Management Act 1996](#), section 6 and section 8.

**4 Meaning of *financial year***

In this Act:

*financial year* means the year that began on 1 July 2024.

**5 Terms used in Financial Management Act 1996**

A term used in the [Financial Management Act 1996](#) has the same meaning in this Act.

**6 Additional appropriations of \$387 714 000**

- (1) If a territory entity is mentioned in a part of schedule 1, column 1—
  - (a) the amount mentioned in that part, column 2 is appropriated to the territory entity for additional net controlled recurrent payments in the financial year for the territory entity; and
  - (b) the amount mentioned in that part, column 3 is appropriated to the territory entity for additional payments to be made on behalf of the Territory in the financial year for the territory entity.

- (2) The amount mentioned in schedule 1, part 1.6 (Treasurer's advance), column 4 is appropriated to the Treasurer's advance for the *Financial Management Act 1996*, section 18.

**7 Commonwealth grants**

The *Financial Management Act 1996*, section 17 applies to all appropriations mentioned in schedule 1 except the appropriation to the Treasurer's advance.
