**Penalties**

- for failure to furnish a return within 15 weeks after polling day — a fine not exceeding \$2000
- for furnishing an incomplete return — a fine not exceeding \$2000
- for knowingly furnishing false or misleading information in a return — a fine not exceeding \$5000 or imprisonment for 6 months or both

An agent who has reason to believe that a return may be incomplete because some relevant information has not been provided to him/her may avoid penalty for furnishing an incomplete return by advising the Commission in writing of

- the particulars that have not been obtained
- the reason the particulars could not be obtained
- the name and address of the person believed to have those particulars and the reason for that belief
