



Declaration Voting

If you are claiming a vote in the ACT Legislative Assembly elections but:

- your name cannot be found on the certified list of electors; or
- your name is incorrectly marked as having been issued with a ballot paper

you are entitled to cast a declaration vote.

Before you can be given a vote you will be asked to complete a declaration vote envelope.

Your declaration will be checked against records held by the ACT Electoral Commission, before the Electoral Commissioner decides whether your vote can be counted.

If a decision is made not to count your vote the Electoral Commissioner will advise you in writing.

If your name cannot be found on the certified list you will be asked to complete an enrolment form.
