Warrant to arrest defendant where the summons is disobeyed

In the Magistrates Court at Canberra.

To the Commissioner of Police at Canberra, in the Australian Capital Territory, and to all other police officers in the Territory.

WHEREAS on the _____ day of _____, 20____, an information was laid that AB [*etc as in the summons*], and a summons was then issued to AB, commanding [him or her] to appear at _____ at _____ in the Territory, on the _____ day of _____ 20____, at before the court, to answer the information: And whereas AB neglected to appear at the time and place appointed by the summons, and it has been proved upon oath that the summons was duly served upon AB: These are therefore to command you, in the Sovereign's name, forthwith to arrest AB and cause [him or her] to be brought before the court to answer the information, and to be further dealt with according to law.
