Memorandum for accused's information

- (1) The list on the back hereof gives particulars of.....other offences which you are alleged to have committed.
- (2) If you are convicted of the charge of.....firstmentioned above, you may before sentence is passed, if the presiding judge or magistrate so decides and the prosecutor consents, admit all or any of the other offences set out on the back hereof and ask that any of those offences that you have admitted be taken into account by the presiding judge or magistrate in passing sentence upon you.
- (3) If you are convicted and the presiding judge or magistrate does take any of the other offences that you have admitted into account, the maximum sentence that may be imposed upon you will nevertheless be the maximum sentence for the offence offirstmentioned above.
