Notice to parties where the court directs inquiry as to removal of record of memorandum of agreement from register under the Act, schedule 4, clause 9, proviso (e)

WHEREAS it has been made to appear to the Court that an inquiry should be held as to the removal from the register of the record of the memorandum of the agreement in this matter which was recorded on _____ under the *Workers Compensation Act 1951*, schedule 4, clause 9, proviso (e), on the ground that the said agreement was obtained by fraud (*or undue influence or improper means*):

TAKE NOTICE, that you are summoned to attend before the Magistrates Court at Canberra on _____, when the matter will be inquired into by the Court;

And that if you do not attend either in person or by your solicitor or agent on the day and at that time such order will be made and proceedings taken as the Court may think just and expedient.
