Application for summons of medical referee as assessor

[Heading as in request for arbitration.]

THE applicant [*or respondent*] applies to the Court to summon a medical referee to sit with it as an assessor on the ground that questions are likely to arise in the determination as to the condition of the applicant or his or her fitness for employment [*or as the case may be*], and that it is desirable that the Court should have the assistance of a medical referee in the determination of the questions.
