### Warrant for discharge of person under remand

*AB* is detained in your custody under the order of His or Her Honor \_\_\_\_\_, a Judge of the Supreme Court, on a charge of [*as in certificate*], and it has been certified to the judges of this court by the Attorney-General that he or she declines to proceed further on an indictment filed against *AB* for the offence. You are therefore required immediately to discharge *AB* from your custody under the order.
