- Each person wishing to purchase shopgoods fireworks must obtain a permit;
- The applicant must be at least 18 years old and a resident of the ACT;
- This application must be accompanied by the payment of the prescribed fee of \$7.50;
- A valid driver's licence or equivalent photographic identification must be presented in order to obtain a permit;
- If the location where the fireworks will be used is on unleased land, then written approval from the relevant Government authority must accompany this application.

The information sought on this form is required to process your application for a Shopgoods Fireworks Purchaser's Permit authorising the purchase and use of shopgoods fireworks in the ACT. The information may be disclosed to Commonwealth, Territory or State government agencies authorised by law. Information provided is protected by the *Privacy Act 1988*.

Fees

The application fee for the permit is **\$7.50**.

Requirements and Conditions

The Shopgoods Fireworks Purchaser's Permit is subject to the following main terms and conditions:

- ☞ The purchaser must be at least **18 years old**.
- ☞ The permit **authorises the purchase and use of shopgoods fireworks only** as defined under the *Dangerous Goods Act 1975*.
- ☞ The permit is only **valid in the Australian Capital Territory and is non-transferable**. The purchaser should retain the permit as an authority to purchase, possess and use fireworks.
- ☞ The shopgoods fireworks may **only be purchased during the 14-day sale period** shown on the permit.
- ☞ Fireworks may **only be discharged on the Queen's Birthday long weekend between the hours of 5.00pm and 10.00pm**. A penalty will apply if you are found in possession of fireworks after this period or use fireworks outside of the permitted times.
- ☞ The shopgoods fireworks must be used by or remain **under the immediate supervision of the permit holder at all times**.
- ☞ The shopgoods fireworks must be used in a manner so as **not to endanger any person, animal or damage property**.
- ☞ If you intend using **unleased land** for fireworks, **prior written approval** must be obtained from the relevant Government authority and a copy submitted with this application form. For information relating to obtaining approval for the use of unleased land telephone **6207 7132**.
- ☞ Fireworks may **not be used during a total fire ban**. It is the permit holder's responsibility to check that a total fire ban is not in place at the time of using fireworks. For information relating to fire bans telephone **6207 8603**.
- ☞ A person may **not receive more than 50kg of shopgoods fireworks** under a shopgoods fireworks purchaser's permit without first obtaining a "License to Keep Explosives".

A person who fails to comply with the requirements of the Dangerous Goods legislation or any condition specified in the permit is liable to prosecution or a penalty.



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
