### Acknowledgment under Administration and Probate Act, section 56

Acknowledgment made under the *Administration and Probate Act 1929*, between [*name or names*] executor [*or* executors] of the duly proved will [*or* administrator] [*or* administrators with the will annexed], of [*name*] late of [*address and occupation as in will*] deceased, of the one part, and [*name or names*] [devisee or devisees] under the will, of the other part whereby the executor [*or* executors *or* administrator *or* administrators] acknowledge that the devisee [*or* devisees] is [*or* are] entitled for the estate for which the same is devised to him or her [*or* them] by the will to the real estate described in the will as [*described as in will*].
