

## Form 3.7 Notice of intention to apply for probate

*Court Procedures Rules 2006*

(see r 3006 (Grant of representation—notice of intention to apply to be published in newspaper etc))

In the Supreme Court of the Australian Capital Territory

Probate jurisdiction

In the estate of (*full name of deceased person, including any known alias*), late of (*last address*), deceased

[I/We], (*name\*(s)*), intend to apply to the Court not less than 14 days, and not more than 3 months, after the day this notice is published for probate of the will dated (*date*) \*[and codicil\*(s) dated (*date\*(s)*)] of the deceased person to be granted to \*[me/us].

*\*(include if address shown in the will for the deceased person is different from \*[his/her] last-known address)* The deceased person's address shown in the will is (*state address shown in will*).

All documents in relation to the estate may be served on \*[me/us] at the following address for service: (*state address for service*).

Creditors of the estate are required to send particulars of their claims to the address for service.
