1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Electoral (Official Mark on Ballot Paper) Approval 2008*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

3 Approval – Printed ballot paper

For the purposes of section 114(3) (Ballot papers) of the Electoral Act 1992, I approve the official mark on printed ballot papers to be the security screen that, when applied to a ballot paper, also produces a black area if the paper is copied or reproduced. A printed copy of the security screen, certified by the Electoral Commissioner, is held at the office of the Electoral Commissioner on file ec2007/053.

4 Approval – Electronic ballot paper

For the purposes of section 114(3) (Ballot papers) of the Electoral Act 1992, I approve the official mark on electronic ballot papers to be the ballot paper generated by the eVACS program approved under section 118A (Approval of computer program for electronic voting and vote counting) of the Electoral Act 1992.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes the approval of approved form AF2004-20.
