## Postal vote for the ACT Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elected Body election

### Information for the elector

- You expect to be unable to attend a polling place; or
- Your address has been suppressed from the electoral roll.

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### You need to:

- 1** Read this information in this pack.
- 2** Check that your name and address are printed correctly.
- 3** Sign and date the declaration.
- 4** Follow the instructions on your ballot paper by numbering boxes next to candidates in the order of your choice.
- 5** Put your folded ballot paper in the postal vote form envelope and seal it.
- 6** Put the sealed envelope, including the completed postal vote form, in the reply paid envelope.

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Please mail or deliver your completed postal vote to the ACT Electoral Commission as quickly as possible.
