- The certificate of title or production of title consenting to the registration of this document is required for lodgement.
- All information should be typed or clearly printed. If completing this form by hand please use a solid black pen only.
- This office will not accept lodgement of this form if it is not completed in full.
- Any alteration to information provided on this form must be struck through with a black pen. Substitute information must be clear and all parties must sign in the margin. Do not use correction fluid or tape.
- One form of Primary Identification Original or Certified Copy of Birth Certificate, Citizenship Certificate or Passport
- One form of Secondary Identification Original or Certified Copy of Drivers Licence, Medicare Card, Pension Card or Tax File Number Declaration issued by the Australian Taxation Office.
- Execution by:
  - a) A Natural Person Should be witnessed by an adult person who is not a party to the document.
  - b) Attorney if this document is executed by an Attorney pursuant to a registered power of attorney, it must set out the full name of the attorney and the form of execution must indicate the source of his/her authority e.g. "AB by his/her attorney XY pursuant to Power of Attorney ACT Registration No..... of which he/she has no notice of revocation".
