# An Act to amend the Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance) Act 1983

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

#### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance) Amendment Act 2000 (No 2).

#### 2 Commencement

This Act commences on 1 July 2000.

#### 3 Act amended

This Act amends the Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance) Act 1983.

#### 4 Imposition of levy

- Section 68 is amended by omitting subsection (1) and substituting the following subsection:
  - "(1) If a person is convicted on or after 1 July 2000 of an offence that this Part applies to (regardless of when the offence was committed), the person is liable to pay the Territory a levy of \$50.".
