**An Act to amend the *Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance)
Act 1983***

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance) Amendment
5 Act 2000 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on 1 July 2000.

3 Act amended

This Act amends the *Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance) Act 1983*.

4 Imposition of levy

5 Section 68 is amended by omitting subsection (1) and substituting the following subsection:

“(1) If a person is convicted on or after 1 July 2000 of an offence that this Part applies to (regardless of when the offence was committed), the person is liable to pay the Territory a levy of \$50.”
