**Discrimination (Amendment) Bill (No. 3)

**A BILL
FOR**

An Act to amend the *Discrimination Act 1991*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

- 5 1. This Act may be cited as the *Discrimination (Amendment) Act (No. 3) 1994*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Act

- 10 3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Discrimination Act 1991*.¹

Conciliation

4. Section 80 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsection:

5 “(2) Evidence of anything said or done in the course of conciliation proceedings in relation to a complaint is not admissible—

(a) in subsequent proceedings under this Act; or

(b) in proceedings, pursuant to section 94, for the review of a direction or other decision of the Commissioner;

relating to the complaint.”
