An Act to amend the Coroners Act 1956 and the Crimes Act 1900 consequent on the enactment of the Intoxicated Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1994

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

5

1. This Act may be cited as the Intoxicated Persons (Consequential Amendments) Act 1994.

Commencement

2. (1) Section 1 and this section commence on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*.

(2) The remaining provisions commence on the day on which section 3
of the Intoxicated Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1994 commences.
