An Act to amend the Crimes Act 1900

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Crimes (Amendment) Act (No. 3) 1992.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazette.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Crimes Act 1900.1
